- The Sanford S. Shorr Education Awards are made annually by the Midstate Chamber of Commerce for up to three graduating high school students.* Each of the three awards is for \$1,000. This award is **based on community** service for students to continue their education past high school. The essential criteria consist of high character, service to community, school, and others. Applicants must demonstrate community service hours that are over and above the basic graduation requirements.
- One additional Sanford S. Shorr Education Award of \$1,000 may be made to a student who is returning to college having completed least one full year of college. This is an award based on community service beyond high school. The essential criteria consist of high character and service to community, school and others.
- The **Hispanic Outreach Leaders in Action Committee** is pleased to make up to two \$1,000 awards for a graduating Hispanic high school student(s).* Applicants will self-select based on their own ethnicity.
- The Young Business Leaders of CT is pleased to make an additional \$1,000 award named the Dan M. Hunter Community Service Education Award. This award is given annually to an area graduating high school student who shows exemplary grades in the classroom, above average participation in school-related activities, and has proven to be a valued asset to the community in which he/she lives or attends school.* The guidelines of this award are based on the ideals of Dan Hunter, who believed in hard work, family, and serving his community.
- The Chamber will also be accepting applications for the Bruce H. Kannenberg & Jonal Laboratories, Inc. Education Award. This is a 4 year award for \$1,000 per year for a Meriden resident graduating from a Meriden **Public School** who will be pursuing a degree in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) or Business.

All applications must be completed in full with current letters of recommendation and required signature below. Annual disbursements will be paid to the student in two installments in the first and second semester, each payable upon receipt by the Chamber of a paid tuition statement to the student. Letters of reference must be current (not more than 12 months old).

- On a separate piece of paper, please type a brief essay on the following topic: How has your service to school, community and others added meaning to or changed the life of others? How is an individual, organization or a community been made different because of your service? Please include evidence of leadership, commitment, independent judgment, self direction and flexibility.
