Wilcox THS Uniform Guide 2020-2021

Being prepared for school is an essential part of learning. Your journey towards success begins at home. Disconnecting from your electronic devices, getting a good night's sleep and eating a healthy breakfast will help you be more alert and focused. Next, arriving at school prepared with necessary materials for your classes supports your ability to better engage the learning process in a proactive manner. Finally, reporting to school fully compliant with our uniform expectations minimizes disruptions and reduces loss of instructional time. By creating this easy-to-follow reference guide, we hope to further support your success.

Student IDs

- All students must wear their current Wilcox THS student ID from the time they <u>enter</u> the building until they leave.
- IDs must be visible and worn above the waist.
- Only, EXCEPTION ~ when wearing an ID poses a safety issue in your CTE program of study. Teachers will provide specific information on this.

Footwear

- All students should <u>enter</u> Wilcox THS wearing shoes that are close-toed and have a back.
- **NO** sandals, flip-flops, or slippers are allowed.
- Students must wear required footwear during the CTE cycle.

Earbuds

Earbuds should not be worn in the building. All earbuds must be removed upon entering the building and should not be used until outside of the building (exception: emergencies requiring evacuation-students are not allowed to use any electronic devices during emergencies.

Academic Uniforms (Grades 9-12)

All students must wear any of the Wilcox THS shirts from Darter Specialties. During the academic cycle, students must wear pants at the waist. Pants must NOT have holes, rips, or tears in them. Sweatpants, leggings, yoga pants, pajama pants, wind pants, nylon, or any other types of athletic pants are NOT allowed.



CTE Program of Study

Being prepared is part of the student's overall grade in his/her CTE program of study.

Grade 9 students must have the following items for all Exploratory cycles:

- Blue exploratory T-shirt or sweatshirt from Darter Specialties.
- Safety glasses
- Work boots
- Jeans or Dickies Pants (no holes)
- Student ID

Grades 10 & 12 (Reminder: Uniform Responsibilities)

- CTE program specific uniform **and** tools
- Safety glasses (if applicable)
- Student ID
- Work boots or trade-specific footwear
